

AIA North Color Guard:

As per our 2018 Seeding Instructions, only classes with more than nine units will be seeded and then randomized by groupings. Classes with fewer than nine (IO, IA, A1, A2, IRA, and MS) were randomized as they have been in previous years. The three remaining classes (SRA2, SRA1, and A3) will be seeded according to the seeding formula.

Following the TJ Competition on 3/25, the units in these classes will use their most recent scores to determine placement.

Units that did not compete on 3/25 will have their score normalized to that weekend by adding 1.5 points for each weekend in March, and 2 points for each weekend in February.

After the seeding list is compiled, these classes will be split into thirds. The highest scoring units will then be randomized and perform last in the class block; the middle units will be randomized and performing in the middle of the class block, and the lowest will be randomized and perform at the start of the class block.

SRA2: (21 units). Highest seven, middle seven, lowest seven

SRA1: (11 units). Highest four, middle three, lowest four

A3: (16 units): Highest five, middle six, lowest six.
