Unit Directors must wear the directors' badge(s)/credentials provided by AIA throughout the 2018 season.

**Wristbands:** Each percussion unit will be provided with performer wristbands and a maximum of ten (10) staff and volunteer wristbands. They will be different.

**Arrival/Unit Parking/Bus Parking:** Please follow all signage and directions provided by the parking attendants to ensure smooth flow for equipment drop off and unit check in. Unit vehicle/truck/bus entry is designated on the "outside map" and is located behind in the area outlined in "RED" and labeled as "Equip/Bus Parking". **PLEASE be aware that percussion units may practice outside and if so, they will be in this area.** **\*\*ALSO NOTE\*\* do not drive or park in the circle marked for floor folding (which is outside Doors 11 and 12).**

**Unit Check In/Registration:** Enter through Door 12 and take a left down the first hallway to **room F107** on the inside map. Directors should check the schedule to ensure they arrive at their assigned time.

**Student Hosts:** student hosts will be **offered** to the following classes only: PSCA, PSRA, and WIA. You do not have to accept a student host if you don't want one. For Finals performances, please report to Unit Check In again to be assigned a student host. All other classes should familiarize themselves with the maps provided to ensure a smooth migration throughout the day.

**Prop/Equipment Unloading/Storage:** When it is time for you to enter in to rotation, unload all equipment and enter through Door 12. Follow the green arrows on the "inside map" to either warm up area. Storage is noted on the "inside map".

**Unit Holding Area:** Is in the cafeteria.

**Performer Dressing Room:** Is in the middle of the hallway behind the gym and down from the on-deck area.

**NOTE:** Performers, please refrain from using the **spectator's restrooms for dressing.**

**Warm-Up A:** Is in room G125 and can be accessed through Door 12.

**Warm-Up B:** Is near the spectator entry. You must enter through Door 12 and travel down the hall, past concessions until you are near the #1 on the indoor map.

**Warm-Up Room Timekeeping:** Timekeepers are instructed on how to keep time for your warm up. Time is to begin according to the schedule that is provided. If your warm up time begins at noon, be at your warm up room before noon so you are ready to go on time. The clock will start according to the schedule,

so it is prudent for the Director to instruct their performers to enter the room and set up quickly. Just like it is important for the Director and performers to exit the room as quickly as possible. When you are given the 1-minute warning by the timekeeper, please wrap up your warm up session and begin exiting your room.

**IF the unit in the warm up room in front of you causes a delay in your entry because they are taking too long to exit, then you will receive your entire warm up interval regardless of the start time.**

**It is important that you understand you must be completely out of the warm up room by the noted "Transit" time on the schedule.**

**Warm-Up Inside or Outside or Both:** You will be asked by unit check in whether you will warm up inside, outside or both. Please let them know so we can let the warm up room timekeepers know what your plans are.

**Timing Line:** Is a vertical timing line.

### **Flash Photography, Videotaping, and Host**

#### **Furnished Photographer:**

Flash photography is strictly forbidden. Your flash can cause a performer to lose their concentration or trip causing injury to the individual and perhaps deduction in score. **Pictures**

**are allowed but do not use a flash.** Due to copyright laws, there should be no unauthorized **videotaping** at any time. Public display of any video in social media and through other digital means is strictly prohibited. **Action photos will be taken by Alexander Rogge during the finals portion of the day.** **Notification for photo availability will be posted on the AIA Facebook page.**

**Floor Folding:** Two options for floor folding are being offered; 1. In the bubble or 2. outside.

**Concessions:** Are available in the cafeteria.

### **Vendors and Team Tables:**

Please visit the cafeteria and/or hallway near the cafeteria and holding area to purchase AIA t-shirts, support teams heading to Dayton, purchase items from

vendors selling color guard related items and so forth. Your support is greatly appreciated.

### **Prelims Scores, Finals Schedule, Recaps**

**and Critique:** Units performing in prelims will be able to find their prelims score and finals placement in the hallway just down from concession. Unit summary scores will be available at the announcers table after each competitive class. The finals schedule will be prepared and emailed to the Directors through Competition Suite and can be picked up in the unit check in room; F107. Recaps will be available at the end of the day. Critique will only be available to those units competing at the WGI World Championships in Dayton, OH.

**Unit Retreat:** Every member of a unit will line up for retreat; however, only captains will be called forward to collect their award. All medals will be provided to the Director. You will be called for retreat by the AIA announcer. Please proceed to the area of the gym near the unit entrance. You will be lined up in the order of performance by class.

**Awards Ceremony:** There will be two (2) awards ceremonies. The first award ceremony will consist of PSCA, PSRA, and WIA classes and will occur during the judge's dinner break (see schedule). All other classes will have their award ceremony at the end of the night. Please exhibit good sportsmanship during the awards ceremony. This is an exciting time for all and patience is important.

**First Aid:** AIA and the host school is offering a first aid room; however, due to potential liability situations and limited volunteers capable of providing such services, the first aid room can only offer minor assistance such as band aids and ice packs. Aid beyond that will require a 911 call to an EMT. Local medical facilities are listed on a separate page within this packet. First aid is located just before concessions.
