TICKET PRICES/INFO:

Tickets are available for presale through Crown Coliseum. Presale ticket holders must pick up a wristband from the box office for reentry.

Adult (13 and up)..... \$25

Child (6-12).....\$15

Children 5 and under get in free.

Doors open at 8:00am for performers and staff only.

Doors open at 9:00am for spectators.

Each ensemble will be provided with up to ten (10) wristbands for staff and chaperones. Unit directors should wear the directors' badges provided by AIA. Staff and performer wristbands are valid on both days.

UNIT REGISTRATION: Early registration for all units (winter guard, percussion and winds) will be at **Crown Coliseum from 6:00pm until 9:00pm on Friday, March 29th**. Any units that do not check-in will need to check-in at their scheduled arrival time on the day of competition.

ARRIVAL (DAY OF SHOW): Please enter off Owen Drive Extension at Coliseum Drive. **STUDENTS AND VOLUNTEERS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED INTO CROWN COLISEUM WITHOUT A WRISTBAND.**

PROP STORAGE: Prop unloading should enter off Owen Drive at **Loading Dock Entrance road**. Props and floors are stored behind the black curtain in the performance area.

FLOOR FOLDING: Floor folding is outside the coliseum by the loading dock as indicated on the included map.

BUS/TRUCK PARKING: Buses and trucks should park in their designate alpha lot space only during their assigned warm-up time. After the assigned warm-up time buses and trucks will be moved to the reloading area. See maps for more information. If you arrive before your assigned rehearsal time you will be redirected to park in a dirt parking lot.

DRESSING ROOMS: Please do not get dressed in the front side restrooms. Dressing rooms are located on the south side of the concourse level of the arena, near section 111. Please do not leave your belongings in the hallway outside of the dressing rooms. Units may store their belongings and wait in sections 111, 112, and 113. Please be aware that these sections are within the performance arena and should be kept quiet out of respect to the performing unit.

PHOTOGRAPHS: A group photography area will be located at near the escalators accessed by section 112. Units may utilize this photography area after their performance time.

WARM-UP AREA: Please see included maps. Units have been preassigned warm-up space in the North parking lot. Units may utilize their assigned parking lot space during their assigned warm-up times.

In the case of inclement weather, there are two tents designated for warm-up as indicated on the map. Directors may utilize their assigned tent during their assigned warm-up times.

PERFORMANCE FLOW: Percussion and winds units will utilize a vertical timeline. All units will enter and exit through the bay doors on the North side of Crown Coliseum. See posted maps for more information.

AWARDS: All items that come into awards with performers need to leave with performers. **NOTE: NO BUBBLES OR HELIUM BALLOONS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE.**
