#### **TICKET PRICES/INFO:**

Tickets are available for presale through Crown Coliseum.

PRESALE TICKET HOLDERS MUST PICK UP A WRISTBAND FROM THE BOX OFFICE FOR REENTRY.

Adult (13 and up)......\$25 Child (6-12).....\$15 Children 5 and under get in free.

DOORS OPEN AT 8:15AM FOR UNITS AND STAFF ONLY.
DOORS OPEN AT 9:00AM FOR SPECTATORS.

Each ensemble will be provided with up to ten (10) wristbands for staff and chaperones. Unit directors should wear the directors' badges provided by AIA. Staff and performer wristbands are valid on both days.

**UNIT REGISTRATION:** Early registration for all units (winter guard, percussion and winds) will be at **CROWN COLISEUM FROM 6:00PM UNTIL 8:00PM ON FRIDAY, MARCH 24TH.** Any units that do not check-in Friday will need to check-in at their scheduled arrival time on the day of competition.

ARRIVAL (DAY OF SHOW): Please enter off Owen Drive Extension at Coliseum Drive. STUDENTS AND VOLUNTEERS WILL NOT BE ADMITTED INTO CROWN COLISEUM WITHOUT A WRISTBAND. A DIRECTOR OR REPRESENTATIVE MUST BE PRESENT TO CHECK IN A UNIT.

**PROP STORAGE:** Prop unloading should enter off Owen Drive at LOADING DOCK ENTRANCE ROAD. Props and floors are stored behind the black curtain in the performance area.

**FLOOR FOLDING:** Floor folding is outside the coliseum by the loading dock as indicated on the included map.

## BUS/TRUCK PARKING:

Buses and trucks should park in their designated alpha lot space ONLY during their assigned warm-up time. AFTER YOUR



ASSIGNED WARM-UP TIME BUSES AND TRUCKS SHOULD BE MOVED TO THE RELOADING AREA IN THE NORTH VIP LOT. See online maps for more information. IF YOU ARRIVE BEFORE YOUR ASSIGNED WARM-UP TIME YOU WILL BE REDIRECTED TO PARK IN THE DIRT PARKING LOT.

DRESSING ROOMS: DO NOT GET DRESSED IN THE FRONT SIDE RESTROOMS. Dressing rooms are located on the south side of the concourse level of the arena, near section 111. DO NOT LEAVE YOUR EQUIPMENT/BELONGINGS IN THE HALLWAY OUTSIDE OF THE DRESSING ROOMS. Units may store their belongings in back lower level before this performance time. Units should NOT TALK, SOCIALIZE, OR SIT IN THIS AREA OUT OF RESPECT TO THE ON DECK AND PERFORMING UNITS. ALL BELONGINGS SHOULD BE REMOVED FROM THIS AREA AFTER YOUR PERFORMANCE TIME.

CLEAR BAG/MASK POLICY: Crown's clear bag policy does not apply to equipment bags, uniform bags, or performer bags prior to their performance time. After your performance upon reentering performers must follow the venue clear bag policy. Masking is determined by Crown, as of publishing there is no mask requirement, more information can be found at

**PHOTOGRAPHS:** A professional photographer will be located in Expo C accessible via the escalators accessed near section 111 for group photos. Units may utilize this photography area after your performance time.

WARM-UP AREA: Please see the alpha lot map and logistic schedule for your preassigned warm-up times and location in the Alpha lot. Units MAY UTILIZE THEIR ASSIGNED ALPHA LOT/TENT SPACE ONLY DURING THEIR ASSIGNED ALPHA LOT WARM-UP TIMES. In the case of inclement weather, there are two tents designated for warm-up as indicated on the map. PLEASE NOTE THAT ALPHA LOT TIMES AND TENT TIMES ARE DIFFERENT DUE TO SPACE LIMITATIONS.

**PERFORMANCE FLOW:** Percussion and winds units will utilize a vertical timeline. All units will enter and exit through the bay doors on the North side of Crown Coliseum. See posted maps for more information.

AWARDS: All items that come into awards with performers need to leave with performers. NOTE: NO BUBBLES OR HELIUM BALLOONS ARE ALLOWED INSIDE.
